Reports Cards will be mailed out shortly, along with Class and Individual School Photographs.

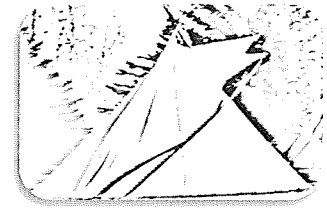
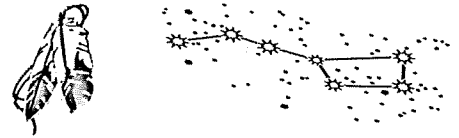
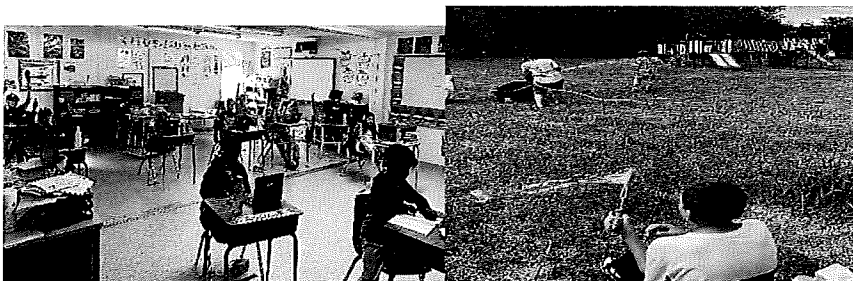
Registration Forms are now available at the school and Band Office for Kindergarten to Grade 6 for the 2021-2022 school year.

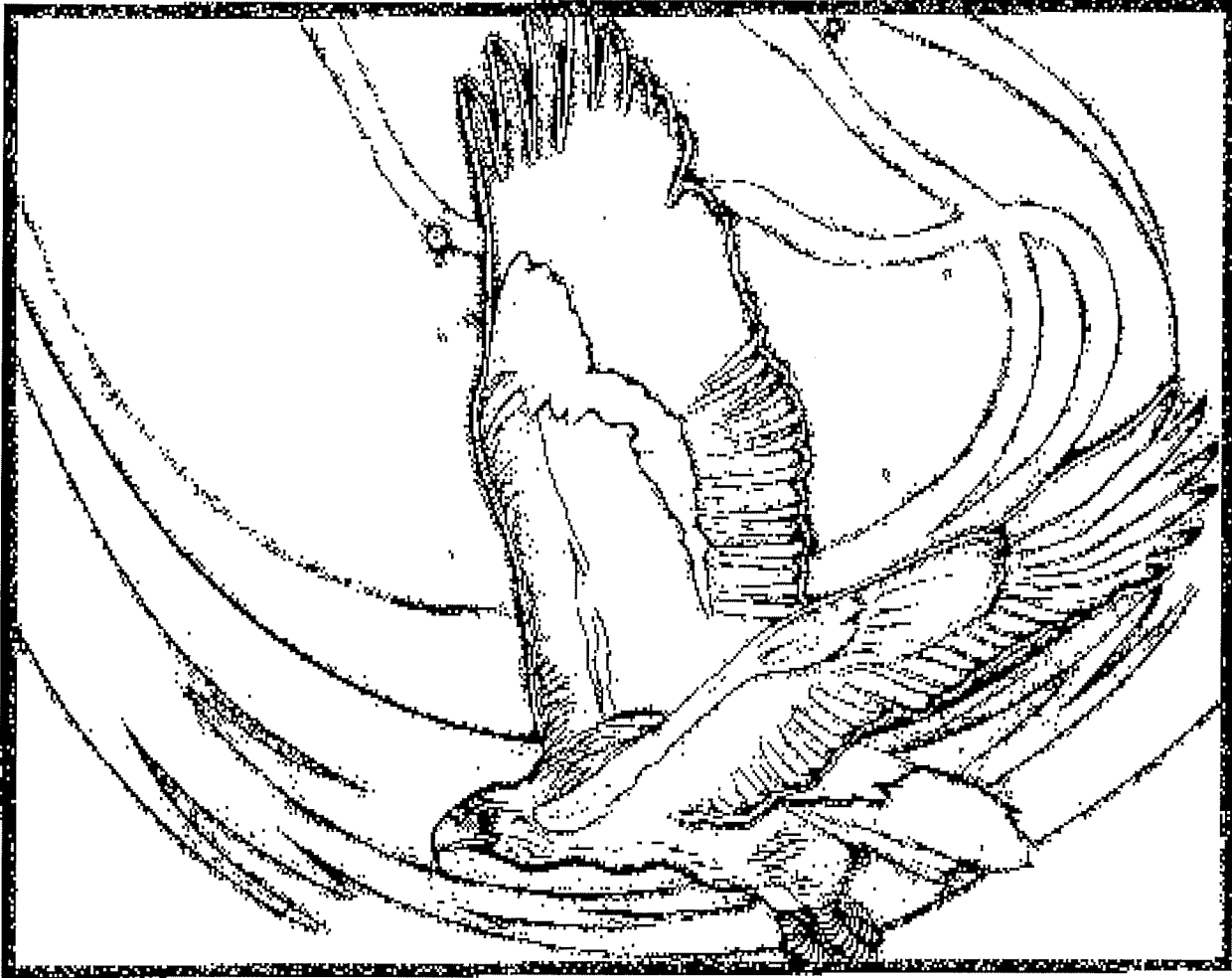

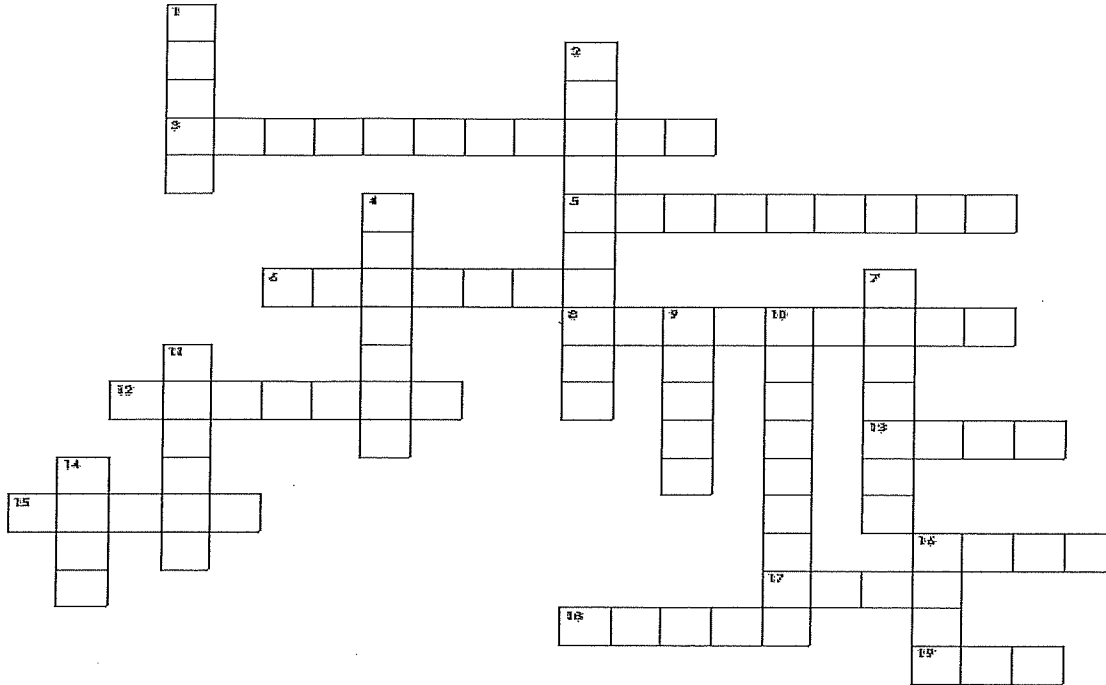
