

Jasper National Park is looking for a motivated individual who is able to fill one **Type 1 wildland firefighter position** for this summer. **Starting as soon as possible, lasting approximately 6 months from the date of hiring.**

A few details about the job:

- Classification is GT-02
- Wage is approximately \$27.00/ hour
- Hours of work are 8.5 per day
- Days of rest are Thursday and Friday with an extra Saturday every other week
- Overtime hours are paid out
- Housing is provided (you will be required to pay rent)
- We are encouraging applicants who are youth
- Parks will supply the uniform, boots and other Personal Protective Equipment you need

Preference may be given to:

- Members from [Indigenous partner communities](#) with connection to Jasper National Park
- Applicants who have basic fire training (S-131)
- Applicants who have experience in firefighting operations (Type 1 or 2)
- Applicants who have completed high school or who have some high school and experience as a firefighter
- Applicants who have some post-secondary education (college or university) in natural sciences (biology, forestry, ecology, natural resource technician)

Training & Requirements:

As Type 1 fire fighter you would be trained in:

- Helicopter safety and helicopter hover exit;
- Chainsaw operations;
- Ignition operations and;
- Fire suppression operations.

As a Type 1 firefighter you will be required to:

- work some weekends;
- be available for potential standby and overtime work;
- complete the WX-Fit test with a 14:30min time.
