Employment Opportunity Full – Time NNADAP WORKER

The Swan River First Nation Health Centre has an immediate job opening for a full-time NNADAP Worker. The NNADAP Worker will report directly to the Health Director and work collaboratively with the health team.

Qualifications:

- Completion of a certificate, diploma or degree in Addictions Counselling and/or in Social Work or Counselling with Addiction Training.
- Demonstrated sobriety for a minimum of at least two (2) years and to abstain from the use of alcohol and/or abuse of drugs and/or gambling.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Mediation and negotiations skills.
- Good problem solving and conflict resolution skills.
- Knowledge of casework/counselling techniques.
- Knowledge of local culture and traditions.
- An understanding of the impact of residential schools on individuals, families and intergeneration's.
- An understanding of crisis management and the ability to deal with life threatening situations including suicide prevention.
- Ability to provide one-to-one and group counselling.
- Ability to maintain strict client confidentiality guidelines.
- Ability to undertake client intake and conduct client assessments.
- Have an understanding on the impact of trauma.
- Competent in computer skills.
- Valid Class 5 Driver's License.

Responsibilities:

- Provide alcohol and drug misuse counselling and support to individuals, families and groups in the community.
- Assessing clients and developing treatment plans based on the assessment of issues.
- Providing counselling regarding the use and effects of alcohol and drugs.
- Accepting and making referrals to outside agencies.
- Support for individuals and families of individuals in pre- and post – treatment.
- Preparing needs and risk assessments.
- Maintaining a comprehensive understanding of management and the impact of alcohol and drug use issues on individuals, families, and the community.
- Maintaining strict confidentiality guidelines regarding all clients, conversations and referrals.
- Documenting all client encounters in a timely manner.
- Establishing and maintaining rapport with clients, families and community.
- Increase community awareness and understanding about alcohol and substance misuse issues.
- Collaborating with the health team to develop culturally appropriate promotional materials and information for health promotion initiatives related to addictions.
- Coordinating and facilitating educational workshops, seminars and presentations on addiction and related topics.
