Employment Opportunity **Family Support Worker** ***Temporary Full-Time Position***

The Family Support Worker (FSW) is directly accountable to the Swan River First Nation Health Director. The FSW is responsible for offering practical help and emotional support to families/community members experiencing short or long-term difficulties. The FSW will assist clients to help meet their needs in a way that maintains or restores their independence as much as possible. The FSW may be required to carry out additional duties and activities related to the effectiveness and successful implementation of the health department.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist clients who are recovering at home after discharge from hospital, as well as provide temporary help in the home to families/persons in need. These duties may include general housekeeping, personal hygiene, transportation and meal preparation.
- Assist in facilitating education groups and/or family programs (i.e. Kids in the Kitchen, Collective Kitchen)
- Prepare Meals on Wheels to Clients.
- Maintain client files and be responsible for daily log on work undertaken.
- Must demonstrate a high level of professionalism both on and off the job.
- Responsible to communicate any issues/concerns relating to client(s) immediately to your reporting supervisor.
- Other duties as required.

- Personal Support Worker Certificate, Nursing Assistant Certificate or related experience.
- Current First Aid and CPR.
- Motivated and able to work well in a team environment.
- Capable of working efficiently with little direction.
- Effective Communication skills.
